1 § Territorial Definitions

- (1) Municipality, or Municipal Territory is an area governed by a local body titled ‘Municipality’. The Municipalities are to be led by ‘Governor’, elected with the manner laid out by the Constitution.
 - (a) The Governor has the sole responsibility of legislative and executive local power to the municipality, though they may choose to delegate the legislative power to a local ‘Municipal Council’. The Governor may also choose to delegate parts of their executive power to smaller mayors.
 - (b) The legislative power of the municipalities shall be exercised through Municipal Ordinances. These Ordinances are to:
 - (i) Create a clear boundary for the rules set forth therein,
 - (ii) Not conflict with any National Legislation, Constitutional or Parliamentary,
 - (iii) Be contained to affairs within the Municipality,
 - (iv) Be approved by the Governor.
- (2) The Royal Governorate of Arsaria, or Arsaria, is a special semi-autonomous zone within the Republic, which is bound by the Treaty of Arsaria.
- (3) Tribal Reserve Areas are regions specified to be reserved for lands of the tribal people that were inhabited by those who came before the Republic of Rosava. Construction in these areas are limited to those permitted by the Chancellery, or the appropriate government organs authorised by the Chancellor to give out such permissions.
