



Schooling Act

Administrative Law Title 1

17th of January, 2024

AN ACT TO the goal of schooling within the Republic of Rosava is to educate its citizens on the history and cultures of the republic

The Parliament of the Republic of Rosava, representing its people, with the will of the President of the Republic of Rosava representing the same, and the Chancellor of the Office, enacts the following in its full text for the betterment of the nation;

§ 1. Article I

Municipalities as well as the Federal Government have the right to construct and operate schools, which shall teach a curriculum that has been ordered by the Federal Government or the government of the municipality.

§ 2. Article II

There shall be a distinction between Municipal Schools and Federal Schools. Municipal Schools may oblige students to pay to attend, while Federal Schools will be free and paid for by the Federal Government. Municipal schools are operated by the municipality it is located in, while federal schools shall be operated by the federal government. A federal school may be located anywhere in the republic, including the Kingdom of Arsaria.

§ 3. Article III

Municipalities have the right to enact laws on making education compulsory or not. If it is to be compulsory, the student may choose whether he attend a municipal or federal school.

§ 4. Article IV

Principals and teachers, as well as others employed in a school, shall be paid by the government (by municipality in municipal school, by federal government in federal school).

§ 5. Article V

Schooling fees may not exceed R£ 50 per school year (one week)

§ 6. Article VI

The principal of a school is the individual who has the power to accept a student, expel them or suspend them from the school. None of these actions may be based on the ethnicity, gender, race or sexual orientation of the student.

§ 7. Article VII

Schools may organise their own sport tournaments where they will compete with other schools throughout the republic. This may range from spagball, to soccer, to football or any others applicable.
